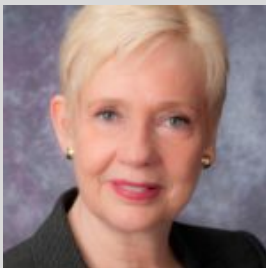
2021 Muse Dinner and Ceremony
